

## PERSONAL SAFETY

### LESSON ONE: IDENTIFYING SAFE AND UNSAFE REQUESTS

**GRADE LEVEL:** 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

**OVERVIEW:** The purpose of this lesson is to establish a framework for later discussions about making decisions in difficult, unsafe or risky situations. In addition, this lesson continues to further explore concepts of personal safety, personal instincts, judgment and bribery.

**GOALS AND OBJECTIVES:** Further introduce students to various issues of personal safety. Continue to strengthen students' decision making ability.

At the completion of this lesson students will demonstrate the ability to:

- Use the decision-making process to assess personal safety risks.
- Understand personal safety issues, including contact with children and adults (i.e. parents, siblings, playmates, relatives, people of authority etc.).
- Distinguish between safe and unsafe requests.
- Identify safety steps for unsafe or risky situations.
- Understand what makes a situation unsafe or risky.
