*Consequences may differ based on actual behavior, school policy, and applicable laws.

Low-level Aggression: name-calling, disruptive or disrespectful behavior such as, rude gestures, sticking out tongue, etc.
Aggression: threats of minor physical aggression, pushing, shoving, slapping
Severe Aggression: Kicking, punching, using objects to hurt others, biting, choking, spitting at someone
Exclusion: Starting or spreading rumors, telling others not to be friends with someone,
Threats of Violence: threats of severe physical aggression, including threats made through comments, notes, gestures, or drawings.
Retaliatory behavior or intimidation: retaliating against someone who made a report, intimidating a witness or target.
Harassment: name-calling or spreading rumors related to gender, sexual orientation, race, religion, ethnic background or disability; touching or grabbing private parts of others.
