4. Review Fall 2021 Field trips

Mr. Conrad reviewed with the school committee members all of the Field Trips currently being offered/ sponsored in the district. The only sixth grade field trip for this year is taking place at Natures Classroom in, New Hampshire. It is being postponed until Spring of 2022 due to current COVID concerns. Once new dates have been set the school committee members would need to vote and approve participation. Five other trips are currently in planning stages, with cancelation windows by the tour companies fast approaching and it can impact a student's ability to get a refund if the trip is cancelled. There was a discussion about State Department Advisories for trips outside the US and what impact these advisories have a student travel trips. School Committee will meet on Friday, September 17,2020, to discuss these trips and decide if they should be cancelled or postponed.

5. BPS Athletics Updates

- Tree Removal by BHS Athletic Fields

Mr. Mangan presented to the school committee a proposal for a cooperative Gymnastics team with the Wilmington School District. If approved Wilmington will be the host school and Bedford will be the visiting school. As proposed the cooperative team will be part of the Middlesex League. Due to the fact that the creation of this team is taking place after the budget process a user fee system would need to be implemented along with fundraising and trying to acquire sponsorships to defray cost to get the program running for this year. The cost per student athlete would be \$400. It would then be a line item during budgetary discussion going forward. Currently five Bedford High School students have shown interest if the team is put together. Some eighth grade students could also be invited to participate if space is available and a waiver is granted. Approximate cost to start the program are: Stipend for coach, transportation cost-\$2000, \$600 for referees etc., along with \$5000 towards facility costs for the season. Mr. Mangan also spoke about the DPW plan for removal of dead or damaged trees near the bleachers at the football field at BHS for safety reasons. It is understood that trees are needed for shade during the warm months when spectators are using the bleachers. However, removing these types of trees would allow for the field to be widened and remove the risk of limbs potentially falling on or near anyone to avoid injury.

- Liaison with CIC Health, our testing contractor, has been finalized

- Test and stay protocol in place. No in-school transmissions have been recorded
- Student sign up for available testing per each school in the district is as follows:
 - 150 at BHS
 - 190 at JGMS
 - 320 at Lane
 - 275 at Davis
- Mr. Conrad will shorten his weekly letter to families and opt for a chart system instead
- September 11, 2021 Mr. Conrad met with Commander Stephens at HAFB to speak about what military family's experiences.
- Mr. Conrad met with State Senator Michael Barret regarding budget and what assistance the district might be able to get from the State.
- DESE Virtual Learning Academy Option
 - Essentially available for medically fragile students and students with documented medical needs
 - Cost to Bedford Public Schools for those that participate
 - Student would be supported by a district teacher and student would still be considered a Bedford student while enrolled
- Educational Assistants/Teaching Assistants (EA/TA) and school nurses' contracts are approved
