Mr. Conrad presented the following information during his superintendent's report to the School Committee. On 8/31, the district was able to return to an in-person opening of school event for all staff. On 9/6 students return to school. Bus routes were released and routes are still being ironed out. All is going as well as it possibly can for the start of the school year. HVAC units are running longer and at the highest possible volume along with HEPA and MERF filters. Masks are available in the district to all that want them. Bedford day is this Saturday. Mr. Conrad met the new Commander at Hanscom, Col. Enriquez. Middlesex Business meet and greet will be held next week. The library at the Lane School will be staffed by Stacy Williams, Instructional Coach and Margie Burke, library support staff.
