6. FY24 Superintendent Budget Presentation

Mr. Conrad presented the Superintendent's FY24 Budget to the School Committee. Some of the talking points discussed are:

- Superintendent's FY24 Budget Proposal
- Increase of 3% is needed for Maintenance of Effort /Level Services
- Additional support of 1% is requested
- Total request of 4% exceeds Finance Committee's 3.5% budget guideline by 0.5%
 - Covers an additional \$150,000 in MOE budget for out-of-district tuition to avoid reliance on a Town reserve
 - o Provides \$83,393 in funding for additional needs
- Staffing request adjusts to lower elementary enrollment (cumulative) keeping all classes within School Committee guidelines
- Additional request for 1.0 FTE elementary reserve teacher due to potential for enrollment changes
- Additional request for 5.6 FTE provides for the district's highest priority proposals to best meet student need

7. Superintendent Report

Mr. Conrad shared the following details during his Superintendent report to the School Committee. Fall Scholar Athletes will be feature in the Boston Globe and Herald. December 21st will be final Lane concert of this year and it will be held at BHS. BHS and Fire Department are holding toy drives. Reminder that Friday, December 23rd will be a half day of school.
