Mr. Mangan, Director of Athletics highlighted the following during his presentation to School Committee members. 28 varsity teams, 10 teams at JGMS and one club team. We have 67 coaches in the district with some coaching multiple sports. Boys soccer has made it to State the last five years. Boys hoops was undefeated, three coaches named as Coach of League while four students were named Player of the Year. Mr. Mangan also gave an update on the Co-Op teams that we have. The Wrestling team made it to States. Girls Ice Hockey is had a great season. Gymnastics is in its second year and still flourishing. JV Ice Hockey has begun to see a decline in its numbers this year. The track will need to be replaced. Mr. Mangan expressed the need to make athletics available to all students without instituting a user fee and to that end spending and fundraising is done to encompass all areas in the athletic department.
